

Praise Him Study Verse: Acts 16:25, John 4:24,

Zephaniah 3:16-17, Matthew 16:15-17

Acts 16:25 Around midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening. John 4:24 For God is Spirit, so those who worship him must worship in spirit and in truth. **Zephaniah 3:16-17** Do not fear; do not let your hands hang limp. The Lord your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you. Matthew 16:15-17 Then he asked them, "But who do you say I am?" Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God. Jesus replied, "You are blessed, Simon son of John, because my Father in heaven has revealed this to you. You did not learn this from any human being.
