

I Wait...

Study Verse: Micah 7:7, Lam. 3:26, Heb 6:15

Micah 7: 7 But as for me, I will watch expectantly for the Lord; I will wait for the God of my salvation. My God will hear me. Lamentations 3:26 It is good that he waits silently For the salvation of the Lord. <u>Hebrews 6:15</u> And so, having patiently waited, he obtained the promise.
